The main objectives of collecting feedback from alumni are as follows:

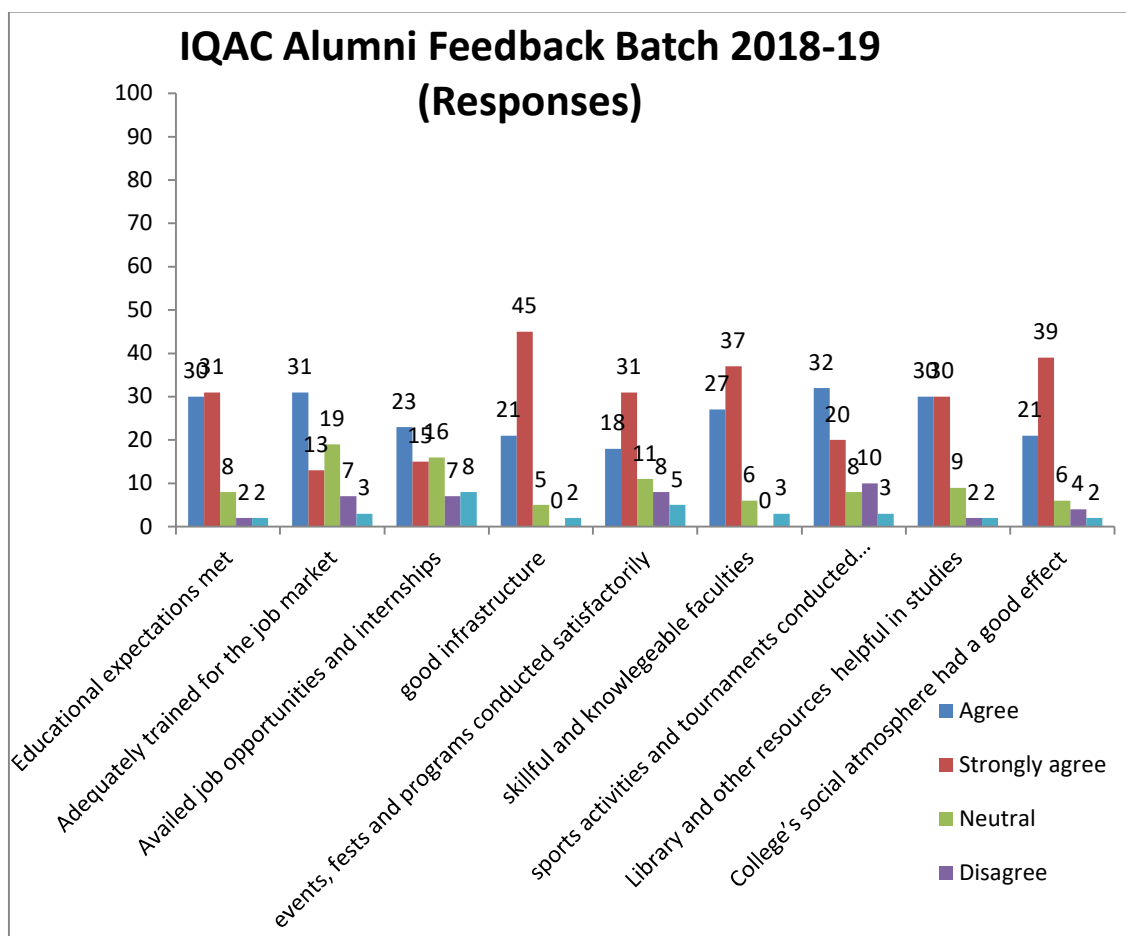
1. Enhance college education quality for students.

1. Educational expectations met by the college
2. Adequately trained for the job market
3. Availed the job opportunities and internships

4. Good infrastructure of the college
5. Events, fests and programs conducted satisfactorily
6. Skillful and knowledgeable faculties
7. Sports, activities and tournaments conducted satisfactorily
8. Library and other resources helpful in studies
9. College's social atmosphere having a good effect



Analysis and Outcome

AAA Cell and IQAC Alumni Feedback for 2018 – 19 (Responses)

- 1) According to the graph above, 31% of alumni strongly believe that the college satisfied their educational objectives.
- 2) 31% believe they have been appropriately trained for the job market

- 3) 23% of alumni believe they can take advantage of job and internship opportunities supplied by the placement cell.
- 4) 45% of alumni strongly feel the college has good infrastructure.
- 5) 31% of alumni highly felt that events, festivals, and programmes were successfully conducted.
- 6) 37% of respondents strongly agreed that the faculty was skilled and informed.
- 7) 32% of respondents found the sports activities and tournaments satisfactory.
- 8) 30% of Alumni strongly felt that the library and other resources were beneficial for studying.
- 9) 39% of respondents strongly agreed that the college's social culture positively influenced them.

Analysis and outcomes:

1. The alumni are satisfied with the college's infrastructure.
2. Alumni praise the college's skilled and knowledgeable faculty.
3. Alumni express satisfaction with the college's social atmosphere.
4. Alumni are satisfied with the college's activities, festivals, and programmes, and believe it has exceeded academic expectations.

Recommendations and suggestions:

1. Alumni recommend expanding the college's sports programmes and tournaments.
2. Alumni emphasized the importance of providing students with proper job market training.
