Analyzing feedback, with a specific focus on the insights provided by parents, is crucial for the quality assurance process. Parents' inputs can help identify areas for improvement, ensuring comprehensive education that fosters the all-round development of students.

To gather feedback, forms were circulated to parents at the end of the even semester. The AAA Cell & IQAC were responsible for distributing and collecting these forms.

Objectives of parent's feedback on institute:

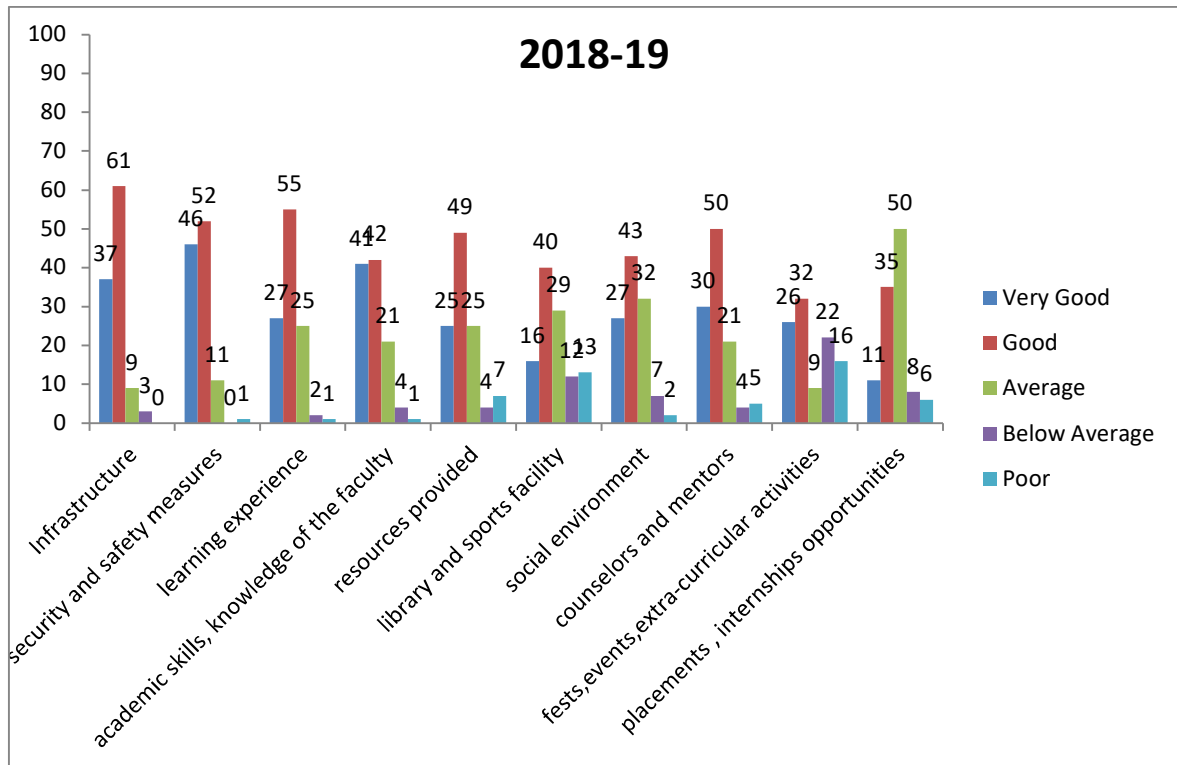
The objectives of collecting feedback from parents can be broadly categorized into three main areas:

1. Examine the effectiveness of the University's curricular structure and pedagogical approaches for delivering syllabi.
2. Evaluate parental response to resources such as libraries, books, digital resources, and infrastructure for instructional aids.
3. Gather input on the institution's impact on the holistic development of students.

Focus of the Parent Feedback Form

The parent's feedback form focuses on the following issues:

1. Infrastructure of the college
2. Security arrangements and safety measure in the college
3. Learning experience of the student
4. Assessment of the academic skills and knowledge of the college faculty
5. Resources provided to students by the college
6. Judge the library and sports facility
7. Social environment in terms of diversity and inclusiveness of the college
8. Opinion about the counselors and mentors provided
9. Fests, events and extra-curricular activities provided by the college
10. Assessment about the placements and internships provided by the college.



Analysis and Outcome

AAA Cell and IQAC Parent Feedback for 2018 – 19 (Responses)

- 1) The graph above shows that 61% of parents thought the college's infrastructure was good.
- 2) 52% of parents consider the college to be safe and secure for their children. 55% said that the college was a good place for their children to learn.
- 3) 42% of parents thought the college teachers had high academic skills and knowledge. 49% of parents believed that college provided adequate resources for students.
- 4) 40% of parents said the library and sports facilities were nice.
- 5) 43% of them believe that the social environment is positive.
- 6) 50 percent of the parents said the college's counsellors and mentors were good.
- 7) 32% of parents think the festivals, events, and extracurricular activities were good.
- 8) 50% of the parents believed that the evaluation of the placements and internship possibilities needed improvement.

Analysis and outcomes

1. Parents are comfortable with the college's infrastructure and believe it is safe for their children.
2. Parents reported positive learning experiences for their children at the college, attributed to knowledgeable faculty.
3. Parents are satisfied with the college's counsellors and mentors

Recommendations and suggestions

1. Recommendations included expanding library resources and improving sports department facilities.
2. Parents felt that the college's placement and internship options should be improved.
